**MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

On this 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter we celebrate Jesus as the Good Shepherd. Jesus identifies Himself as such and in doing so reminds us of how much Jesus cares for us. He laid down His life for us (His sheep).

While we can be like sheep, it is also very helpful that in the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading we hear that we are God’s children.

Regardless of the name or image though, the point is that we belong to Him.

This weekend we celebrate the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. All of us are called to imitate Jesus in laying down our lives for others, but some are called to this more directly within the Church. We therefore specifically pray that our young people will more fully comprehend God’s love and respond to this love by uniting their lives more fully with Christ. In so doing, may more of them be willing to lay down their lives as priests, deacons, and religious.

**CATHOLIC CATECHESIS: DID YOU KNOW?**

Mystagogy is “a liturgical catechesis which aims to initiate people into the mystery of Christ. In a more specific sense, the catechetical period following immediately after the reception of Baptism by adults. (CCC 1075)

“The newly baptized are called ‘neophytes,’ from the Greek words meaning ‘new plant,’ because the faith has been newly planted in them. Even though their catechetical preparation has been completed, they still have much to learn about what it means to live as Catholic Christians. During Mystagogy, new Catholics will reflect on their experience of conversion, learn more about the Church, and consider how they might get involved in ministry and outreach.” [bustedhalo.com/ministry-resources/what-is-mystagogy](http://bustedhalo.com/ministry-resources/what-is-mystagogy)

**IDAHO CATHOLIC APPEAL**
