MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

This week we hear another story of the Resurrection! Jesus had just recently appeared to two of the disciples, and they were telling others of their experience of encountering Him on the road. Then, He appeared to the whole group! A couple of interesting points about these appearances are that Jesus desired to eat something with them and that He helped them to understand the scriptures. In eating something with them, He showed them that He was not a ghost or spirit; this likely triggered many memories and teachings that He had shared with them before. He was now Risen and in their midst! He was preparing them to be His witnesses in the world and He wanted to fortify their understanding and their faith.

Every time that we celebrate Mass, Jesus wants to do the same for us...to remind us of the story and his presence and to fortify our faith so that we might be more effective witnesses as well.

CATHOLIC CATECHESIS: DID YOU KNOW?

In English we use the word Easter to refer to the joyous celebration of the Resurrection. The word itself actually refers more to the time of year, but has become for us so much more significant! Many languages actually still use a word more directly related to the word for Passover in order to celebrate the Resurrection. For example, "Happy Easter" in Latin would be something like "Felice Pascha," or in Spanish, "Feliz Pascua" would be the greeting!



NOW THAT YOU KNOW, HERE'S WHAT TO DO:

Regardless of the words we use, now we celebrate that Jesus is Risen and because of this we share in the blessing of being saved from the reality of death! Say an extra prayer of thanksgiving for this incredible gift and continue to share the message of the season.
